In late 2022 we piloted our Comfort & Care Cart, sponsored by the Jandernoa Foundation, at Helen DeVos Children's Hospital. For a 6-week period, RMHC West Michigan staff spent 3 hours every Friday providing 845 care and comfort items to 231 individuals at the hospital.
